




### About Katrina

My experience in supervisory roles has developed my skills in non-profit management, fundraising, leadership formation, and program development.



On May 8, Catholics around the world observe Good Shepherd Sunday and The World Day of Prayer. The purpose of this day is to fulfill the Lord's instruction to "Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2).

Please pray we all hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to deepen our commitment to our own vocations of priesthood, diaconate, religious life, marriage, and single life.

In the Diocese of Green Bay in recent years, we have been averaging one to two ordinations to the priesthood. Given our Catholic population, we should be ordaining at least three men to the priesthood every year.

Bishop Ricken has expressed a desire to have at least 30 men in the seminary studying for the priesthood in the Diocese of Green Bay by the year 2025. During the past year and a half, 12 young men have entered seminary studies for the Diocese, bringing our number in 2022 to 17 seminarians. It will take us several years to get to the average of 3 to 5 ordinations per year, but together we can reach this goal.

Please pray for the children, youth, and young adults in our Diocese. We have over 8,000 students in our Catholic schools and 14,000 children in our faith formation programs. They are all being called to hear the voice of the Master and the Good Shepherd to lead the life of a disciple who is a friend and follower of Jesus. They are all being called, as are we, to lead a life of holiness. Some of them are being called to be priests, others are called to the Consecrated Life.

Bishop Ricken is calling for everyone to pray for an abundant increase of Church vocations to the priesthood and religious life. He asks you pray every day to the Lord who said to us, "The harvest is rich, but the laborers are few. Pray the Lord send laborers for the harvest."

May God bless you and your commitment to your vocation, your distinct personal invitation from God to become the person God created you to be, using your distinct gifts and talents in building God's Kingdom here and now.
