Celebrating the Birth of the Church as the Body of Christ

Did you know that Pentecost is one of the three major, most important celebrations of our church year? Pentecost is often referred to as the "birth day" of Christ's Church, and who among us doesn't like to celebrate birthdays? Its super deserving of special attention, reflection, and action on our part.



Pentecost has a long history of celebration, originally marked as a harvest festival, celebrated seven weeks after Passover. The Jewish people from all corners of the land, of all languages, race, country of origin, age, gender, customs and traditions would travel to Jerusalem to participate in this feast known then as Shavuot.

In Jesus' time, Shavout had transformed over the years to also include a celebration of God's gift of the Commandments, given to the faithful through Moses; high upon a mountain top God spoke to Moses through the flames of a burning bush. The Commandments set the "laws" for God's people to practice.

As Jesus is quite famously known for, often presenting a "twist" on the old ways, calling for new perspectives and new actions, Shavuot was no exception. Jesus tells the disciples that he, along with God the Father, is going to send an "advocate" to be with the followers now and forever. Why? to assist the faithful in not only following the "laws" but to build relationships with others throughout the world, near and far, connecting through an ever- growing community of love and care, peace and justice for each and every one of God's people.

The Holy Spirit is symbolized by flames of fire (remember Moses' bush?) and suddenly, every one present can receive the same message, no matter their own language and dialect, race, color, country of origin, age, gender, customs and traditions. Jesus transforms Shavout into Pentecost, a new perspective calling God's people to go out to share God's message of nonjudgmental care and unconditional love throughout the world. Regardless of previous divisions, the Spirit enables each of us, using our individual gifts and talents, to transcend all separations to connect with others in the power of God's unifying love – loving all God's people all of the time.

Happy Birthday Church! How will you join the celebration? Take some time this week to contemplate how your household of faith will share of your gifts and talents with our brothers and sisters relegated to living on the margins. Be bold, be brave, be innovative because Christ promised us the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, will be with us every step of the way.






