


## Resurrection Catholic Parish Becoming Disciples of Jesus and Stewards of God's Gifts

#### Fifth Sunday of Easter April 27 & 28, 2024



#### **Operating With Full Bars**

Jesus was the master of the metaphor in his teachings. He could take a complex concept and explain it so skillfully in a way that was easy to understand for the listener. Drawing from everyday, ordinary life, Jesus used metaphors to share who he was and encourage people to see Christ in their daily lives.



In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus uses the metaphor of the vine and the branches to illustrate the importance of being connected to God. Just as good fruit cannot be produced if the branch isn't growing forth from the vine, we too grow and bring goodness when we remain attached to God.

This is a great metaphor for the time. The people Jesus was talking to had more experience with vines and branches. Vineyards were very common in the areas Jesus taught. But what about today? I don't know about you but I don't have much experience with vineyards, except for that occasional glass of wine, which I'm sure doesn't count.

Would Jesus still use the metaphor of the vine and branches if he was teaching today? I'm going to go out on a limb and present a new metaphor: Christ is the cell tower and we are the cell phones. Most of us have a cell phone and understand the importance of those little bars that indicate our reception. When we travel too far from the cell tower or if interference interrupts our connection, we don't work at full capacity.

I challenge you to face the obstacles that disrupt your reception. When do you drop the cell signal from Christ? What walls cut off your connection? Once you've identified those obstructions, take action to remove them and strengthen your reception.

We can boost our reception when we pray quietly, worship together, receive the Eucharist, serve our brothers and sisters, and share laughter and tears with our family and friends. Anytime love is present, when we are loving God with our whole heart or loving our neighbor as ourselves, we have not dropped the cell signal. I invite you to reflect on the times that you are operating with full bars. When are you fully connected to God?

Collection boxes are located in the Greeting Area near the main entrance to church.


