#### Here I Am, Lord. I Come to Do Your Will

As a senior in college at St. John's University, I was an intern at a local parish in St. Cloud, MN, coordinating the First Eucharist program for the second graders. One of the first aspects of the program that needed to be organized and implemented was a



parent meeting, to inform parents of the various parts of the program. The orientation session was held in the church. There were nearly 100 people in attendance. As I began the meeting, my knees were shaking, my voice was quivering, and I was a nervous wreck. I do not think anyone past the first three pews heard anything I said. The next day, the choir director sat down with me and talked about breathing and how to project my voice. But beyond being heard, I was not sure that church work was for me. Yet, later that spring, the Director of Religious Education and the pastor asked if I would take on the role of Youth Coordinator the next fall, because the current person was leaving the parish at the end of the school year. I was being called. But was I the right person for the position? Ultimately, I answered that call and, as they say, the rest is history as I have served in the Church for nearly 40 years now.

In this weekend's readings, there are two classic "calling" stories: Samuel being called by God, and Andrew, John, and Peter being called to follow Jesus. In the first story, Samuel goes to Eli after being called by God, thinking that Eli is calling. After a couple of times, Eli instructs Samuel to respond to God that he is listening, and ready to do God's will. In John's Gospel, Andrew and an unnamed disciple, thought to be John, are told by John the Baptist that Jesus is the Lamb of God, the promised One. They immediately follow and convince Peter to do the same.

What about us? What are we being called to? I know two things: callings come in many ways and for most of us they do not stop. If we are open to these moments of grace, we are constantly being called to use our gifts and talents for the building of the Reign of God. And if you are like me, you sometimes question whether you have the adequate and appropriate gifts to be successful in what you are being called to do or be. Yet, God is calling, through the many people and situations that we encounter every day. Are we listening? Here I am, Lord. I come to do your will!
