I remember when I was in kindergarten back in Little Chute.
I was almost always late for school. The outside doors would always be locked and I would have to go to the classroom window and knock so that they could let me in through the locked door. I got to dreading going to school, yet I knew that if I wanted to gain the goodness of life, I needed to keep knocking on that window.

This is a small example of what Jesus and the disciples must have felt as they proceeded toward Jerusalem. There had been many warnings that their lives were in danger. They knew the risks. Yet Jesus led them to Jerusalem with what seemed like a triumphant arrival that quickly turned into a tragic devastation. They were left to admit to following this man Jesus or to run the other way.

Palm Sunday leaves us in death and desperation as we enter Holy Week. All the disciples could do was to collect Jesus' body and watch where he was laid. Absolute devastation! This week, we are invited to remember the last days of Jesus. When have we resisted going into a difficult situation knowing this was the only way to bring light into darkness? Only faith encourages us to go to places that are sometimes dark and frightening when we would rather run away.

Are we willing to walk the dark roads in our lives that can lead us to light? Or do we avoid the parts of the road that tend to 'cause trouble'? Where do we find enough hope to lead us on this often difficult journey that promises resurrection?

Looking forward to Easter is a call to bring life and hope into our world. May we be instruments of God's light and hope as we walk with Jesus from death to eternal life.


