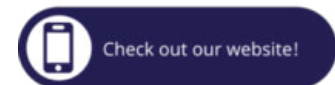

The Cool Kingdom Party comes to Res next week!



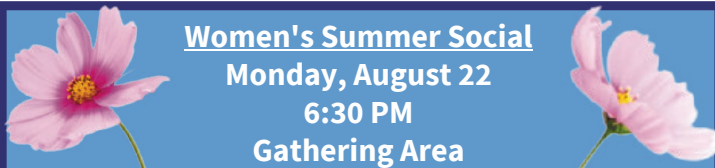
This week-long Vacation Bible School opportunity will help kids and leaders explore, learn, and grow in their Catholic faith.

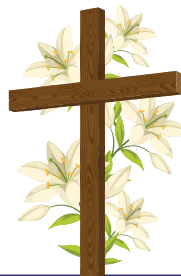
