#### A Solid, Life-Giving Sanctuary

Imagine yourself walking through dry, rocky ground with the sun beating down upon you. The sweat drips from your brow as you wander across the hills, trying hard to keep your footing.



Up ahead, you see an area of lush vegetation and can hear the rush of water. As you grow closer, you feel the temperature drop, the sun's heat is replaced with the cooling shade of tall trees and your nose is filled with the smell of rushing water. You are greeted with a scene of idyllic greenery surrounding a rippling spring flowing from a prominent rock face. This is truly a sanctuary, a place of retreat, a source of peace. Welcome to Caesarea Philippi!

This is the area Jesus brought his disciples in this weekend's Gospel. It is here that Jesus asks Simon Peter, "Who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter identifies him as the Christ, the Son of the living God. Jesus then declares Peter as the rock upon which his church will be built.

Why did Jesus choose Caesarea Philippi for this event? Nothing Jesus did was pure coincidence. Last year, I was privileged to visit this location and I found it to be refreshing and life-giving. It was a place of rest and inspiration. The grandeur of the rock face was uplifting and exciting. It rejuvenated my spirit so that I could continue the journey.

Today, we reflect upon the foundation of the Church. Jesus set forth a Church that would be a respite for the weary and a source of encouragement, just like the area of Caesarea Philippi. 




Tickets are \$20 for adults and \$10 for children 10 and younger.
