## **The Magnificence of Easter – Alleluia!!!**

In S. 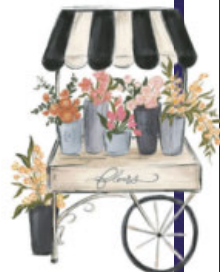


### Spring Fete Deux

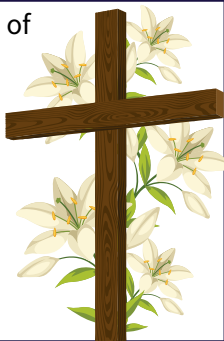
