


Second Sunday of Easter & Divine Mercy Sunday April 15 & 16, 2023


Earth Day Trail Clean Up

2023 PASCAL CANDLE

This year's Paschal Candle has been donated by George Hartman, in memory of his wife, Sharon.

It's entitled, LUKE 24; inspired by the Scriptural passage of Luke 24:

"Why do you search for the dying One among the dead. He is not here, He has been raised up."

This candle features the burial shroud symbolically draped on His cross, his Chi Rho monogram triumphantly crowns the design ensemble.

All this is rendered in wax with copper leaf highlights and burnished with bronze wash.

The Cross and Chi-Rho bands are wax sculptured in high relief.
