

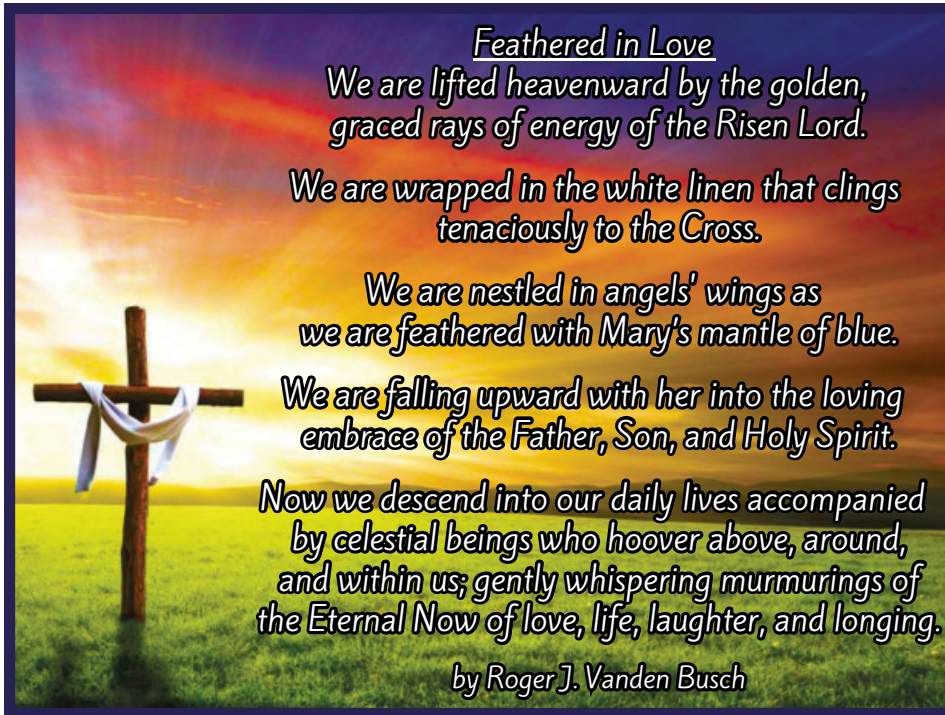

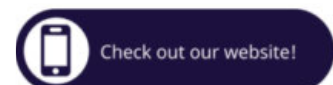

Resurrection Parish is one of four original congregations to sponsor EPH, a local non-profit that provides transitional housing for families in need of shelter.

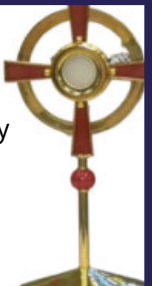
Each year, our parish sends out an appeal letter asking for the necessary funds to operate this invaluable service provider in our community. Look for your letter and please be as generous as you are able.

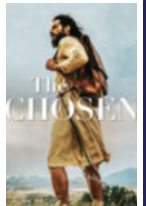


The Chosen Series

It's entitled, LUKE 24;
inspired by the Scriptural passage of
Luke 24:

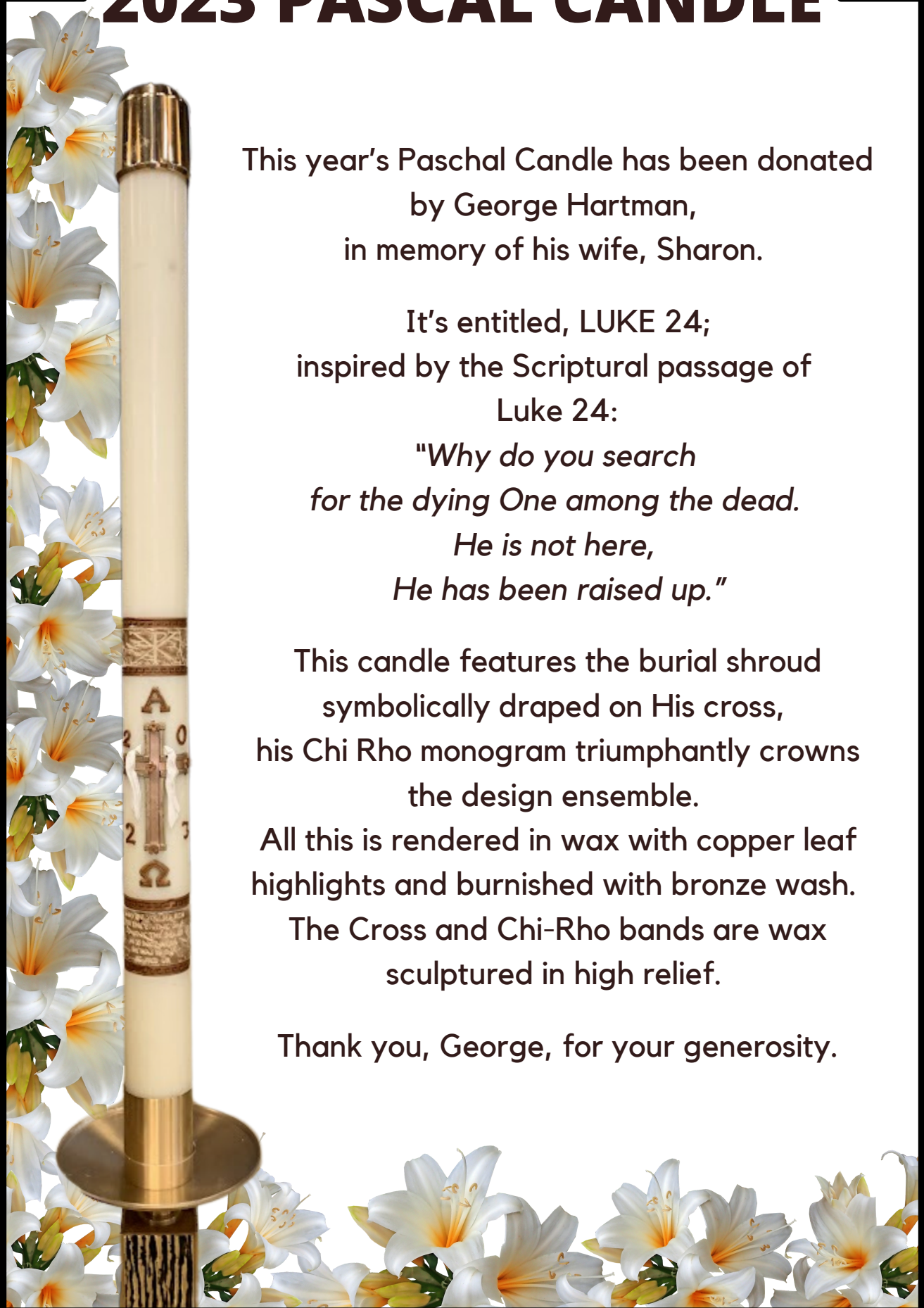
*"Why do you search
for the dying One among the dead.
He is not here,
He has been raised up."*

This candle features the burial shroud
symbolically draped on His cross,
his Chi Rho monogram triumphantly crowns
the design ensemble.

All this is rendered in wax with copper leaf
highlights and burnished with bronze wash.

The Cross and Chi-Rho bands are wax
sculptured in high relief.
