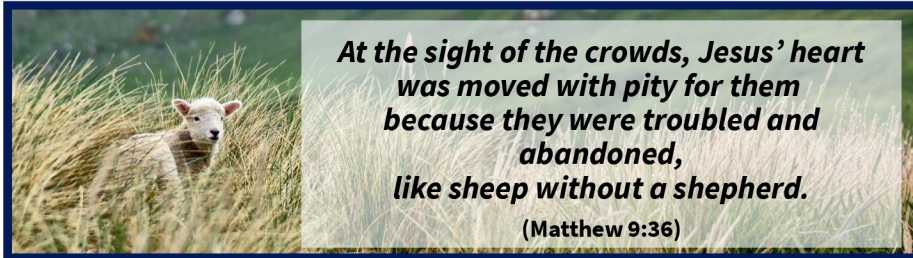

Living Mosaic

Last weekend, as we prepared for my dad's funeral, my family gathered to look through photos of the past. In the midst of the stories and laughter, I was reminded of my youth. Believe it or not, I was a bit awkward during my teenage years and struggled with trying to figure out who I was. I remember in middle and high school trying so hard to conform, scared of standing out, or not following whatever current trend was dominating the hallways. I even hid the things I genuinely loved, like classic movies and TV, worried it made me too "weird." Thankfully, I have since realized the truth: trying to fit into a cookie-cutter mold only suppresses the unique person God created me — and us — to be.

This weekend's Gospel gives us a beautiful antidote to that pressure to conform. When Jesus looks out at the troubled crowds, He doesn't see an abstract mass of people. He sees individual stories, unique faces, specific hurts, and untapped potential. Jesus sees a harvest of souls waiting to be gathered into God's family. He then calls His apostles by name before sending them out to minister to the people. He knows Peter's impulsiveness, Thomas's doubts, and Matthew's complicated past. He knows their strengths, weaknesses, fears, and failings. He calls them anyway. Through our baptism, God does the exact same for us, inviting us to bring our authentic selves into a world that hungers for God's love.

Now, while we often read these scriptures through an individual lens, I challenge all of us to see the powerful correlation of the scripture to the spiritual makeup of our parish communities. A healthy parish, diocese, and world-wide church is a living mosaic where our diverse, unique gifts are woven together by the Holy Spirit to form one beautiful, united body.

In "The Screwtape Letters," C.S. Lewis brilliantly notes that hell desires uniformity by seeking mass-produced, predictable, compliant herds of people stripped of their individuality. Heaven, however, desires unity, which is the exact opposite. Uniformity forces us into an identical mold; unity requires distinct, free individuals choosing to love each other despite and because of our differences.

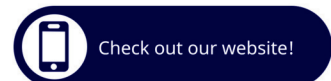
