



Resurrection Catholic Parish Becoming Disciples of Jesus and Stewards of God's Gifts

This is a quote from a homily St. Augustine gave to those who were to receive communion for the first time. He went further: "you ought to know that what you will receive, what you ought to receive daily, the bread that you see upon the



Augustine is reminding us to 'have ourselves in mind' as we reach out our hands to receive the very presence of Jesus. This presence is the heart and soul of our faith. We are challenged to open ourselves to the mystery that this 'Body of Christ' may be our body and soul. This is the radical nature of being in communion with our God. We pray that the simple bread and wine on the altar might become for us the very Body and Blood of Jesus. Yet often we forget that at the Last Supper, Jesus handed his very body and blood, his very ministry of healing and reconciliation, to his disciples. We are meant to be as Christ in our world today.

So each time we reach out our hands to receive the Body, and some day the Blood, of Jesus, we are reaching out to the mystery of how we are to be transformed into the very presence of Jesus in our world today. Believing in the 'real presence' of Jesus is our calling to believe in the real presence of Jesus we encounter in every person and situation we meet in life.


