This weekend we celebrate Corpus Christi, the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. On Saturday morning, we gathered as a faith community to process around the grounds of Church with the monstrance, which contained the Body of Christ. But as we emphasized over this past Lenten and Easter Seasons, the Body of Christ is not merely a thing, which is vastly important, but we



have also learned, by reflecting on Deacon Steve Meyer's book, *Living With Real Presence: Eucharist As An Approach To Life*, that the "This" in "Do THIS in memory of me" is more of a verb than a noun. After we processed with the Body of Christ, we lived as the Body of Christ in the world today by engaging in service in our community with and for those who need our loving and real presence.

This past week, we also uploaded the latest Revealed podcast which featured two of our recent high school graduates, Jillian Joseph and Evan Hoffman. As Katie and I sat down to talk to these two amazing young people who, like Jesus and John the Baptist, knew each other even before they were born, something struck me which relates to this weekend. When we asked Jillian and Evan how their faith life, and specifically involvement in Resurrection Parish, has helped them through their teenage years, they both immediately turned to the topic of service. Their faith life was most enhanced by the mission trips they went on in middle school. It was enhanced by serving coffee and rolls after Mass, as well as heading up the annual Granola Bar Collection. Service sparked their faith, and served as a beginning and foundation of their faith. Volunteering gave them something to look forward to. It showed them the world. And ultimately it humbled them and kept them grounded. Both young people pointed to their mothers as models of service in their lives. For Evan, it was his mom, Nicole, who was involved in Children's Liturgy of the Word and more recently StreetLights Outreach and Amani Outreach with Whatsoever You Do, Inc. For Jillian, it was her mom, Jackie, who serves on the Health and Wellness Committee at Resurrection and helped so many people with their medical and health needs.

We are the Body of Christ. Two young people, who will continue their faith journeys for the next four years on a college campus, show us that reality. Do THIS in memory of me! Evan and Jillian sure do!
