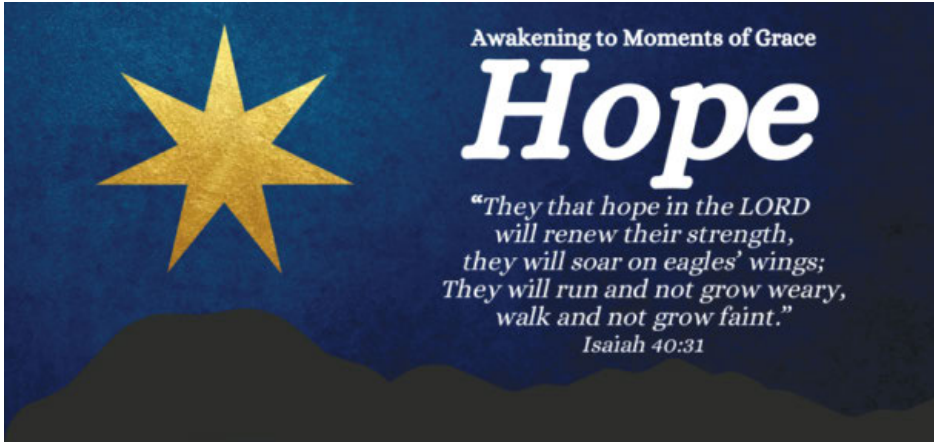

Be Watchful! Be Alert!

There is nothing more watchful or alerting than having a pregnant woman present in her last trimester. All is clearly visible. The signs of new life are there for all to see. The little movements that happen within bring an expectation of new life and hope.



Yet, the watchful and alert warning Jesus is announcing to his disciples was clearly not the birth of the Christ Child but the dawning of faith and hope in the world around them. Advent is a time when we break our normal routine and move into heightened alert to perceive more intensely the ways of Emmanuel, "God-with-us." We are all 'pregnant' with God's Spirit.

So often we 'sleep-walk' through life. We have our routines and familiar people with whom we typically associate. It seems all else becomes a distraction and can put us in a bad mood. Jesus' message was always one of waking up and opening our eyes to greet a whole new world right in front of us. God is always with us and within all those we meet throughout our days. Each moment of time is a new 'MOMENT OF GRACE'.

Isaiah beautifully lays out the scene where God is the potter and we are the clay. It is God's job to form us, not only through the early 9 months, but through every moment of our lives. As soon as we hit 2 years old, we so easily forget where we came from and to whom we shall one day rest. Advent is this time to be more attentive to those moments when God is forming us today.

From Advent through the Easter season, we are all invited to identify those 'moments of grace' when we knew that God's potter hands were active in forming us and creating us anew. There are fish nets hanging on the side walls of the church for you to write down and hang your 'moments' and present them in gratitude toward building the Kingdom of God right here at Resurrection Parish. Thank you for your alertness to God's presence in our midst.

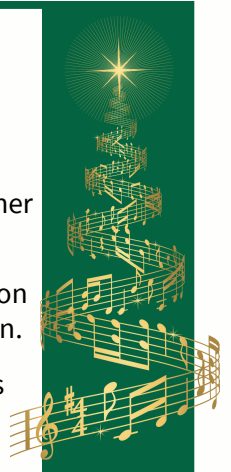

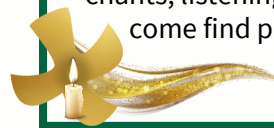

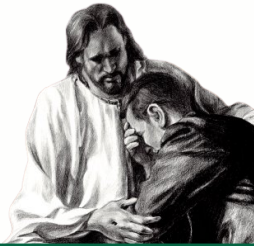
The Rosary is prayed after every daily Mass and Eucharist Adoration is available Thursdays after daily Mass. All are welcome to join in prayer.

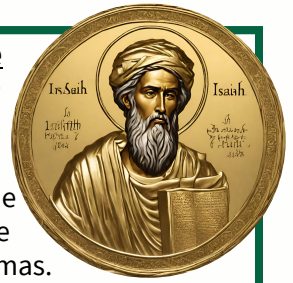

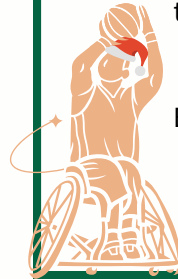
Wheelchair Basketball

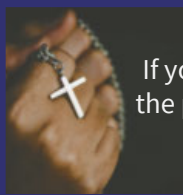

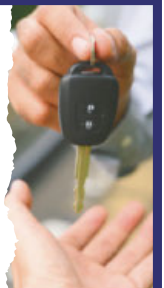
