"Be holy, for I, the Lord your God, am holy."

What do we have to do to be good people? What does holiness demand of us?

Our God, as we understand through Jesus' words, is a demanding God. It is not enough to just be a good person, nor just a kind person. Our readings today speak of us rising up the mountain to a new level of loving consciousness we can not do on our own. It takes a community of faith to inspire us and call us to new life.

So often we are busy and we just want to quickly pass by a situation and get on with our tasks of the day. Yet Jesus reminds us there are moments when we have to stop and see the suffering and pain around us. Today's gospel is filled with situations demanding our attention. When a violent situation happens, such as the shooting on the college campus in Michigan, how do we respond? When an injustice happens in our midst, how can our actions contribute to a healthy solution? When we are persecuted for our depth of belief, how can we respond in a non-violent manner that promotes peace? How do we love God as we love our neighbor? The two are inseparable.

Life in faith is a very difficult path to follow. We can stay in our little world of prayer and it can make us feel good in the moment. Yet our God is asking us to live that same prayerful faith, leading us to action of loving our enemies and transforming our world into the Kingdom of God. As the faith community of Resurrection Parish, we strive to bring the prayers shared at the celebration of the Eucharist into our daily lives in order to bring hope and justice to all. It is a challenging task and yet I believe we are up for the challenge to be holy as God is holy!

Resurrection Parish Family invites you to the Lenten Table to grow as a community, to feed our minds, and strengthen our relationships with each other and the Lord.


