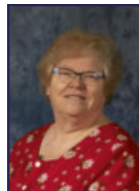

The Christmas Season Continues

Following the church's liturgical calendar, the Christmas Season is still with us and features additional opportunities to celebrate more special rites and rituals. Unfortunately, too many of us are exhausted by the demands of preparing for Christmas and are happy to get back on a "regular schedule" again. I know it well!



However, I hope the challenges brought forth through our parish's Advent theme to "prepare differently" inspired a new perspective or practice to adopt within your own household of faith. Dedicate some time to review what went well or didn't go so well. Take a poll of family and friends; don't forget to include the children or grandchildren. Their input might surprise you! Then, contemplate what seeds need to be planted now for next Advent. I spent about two years silently fretting that suggesting any changes to our family's gift giving traditions would not be well accepted. A few of those year-round get togethers have since blossomed into family traditions with fun practices that have since become honored rituals and the source of some great family storytelling - much more memorable than any Christmas sweater or scented candle gift as shared during the Christmases of our past (wink and grin).

In two weeks, the Liturgical Calendar features a special focus on the Baptism of Our Lord. It's a great weekend to consider connecting with your Godparents, Godchildren, or your children's Godparents. Invite everyone to attend Mass together. Share photos, memories, and bless one another with Holy Water. More presence, deeper relationships, stronger faith connections, sharing love as Jesus does. It's a win-win!

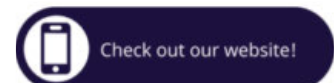

Start the New Year with a resolution to grow in faith with others through prayer and discussion. This is an opportunity to follow Jesus's example; for he sat in circles to listen and teach.

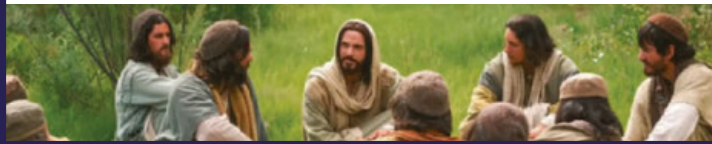

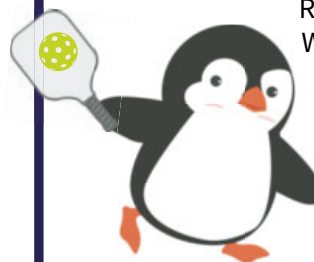

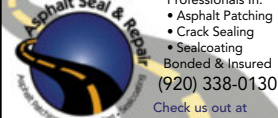
