




Set Me on My Feet

Have you ever been "set on your feet?" There are many times when a toddler is set on their feet. A person going into the workforce in some fashion is "set on their feet" as they accept their new job. I remember feeling a bit on edge as I was "set on my feet" at my ordination!

I cannot imagine what Ezekiel the prophet felt when he was called to confront Israel with the news from Yahweh that their God was not too happy with their rebellion.



Often times, I especially hear grandparents speak of family issues that arise. They don't know how to approach them in a way that does not split the family and yet addresses the issue. Not getting married in the church, grandchildren not getting baptized, abusive situations that are unhealthy, are just a few issues seen in families. I hear their love for their families, and I hear their conscience pushing them to speak up in a prophetic manner. As we are celebrating the birth of our nation, how are we to be prophetic in holding on to the ideals we hold as a nation that brings life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness to all citizens.

Ezekiel gives us a perspective that "sets us on our feet." The bottom line is that we show up! Yahweh's understanding of the situation was not that Israel would be completely transformed in a single moment by Ezekiel's pronouncement. Yahweh took the long view of life, one message of hope at a time, a consistent reminder of who we are as a people of God. The effort it takes to step forward with courage and compassion is noticed by all. That is giving witness to truth and a loving relationship.

May we be "set on our feet" this week to witness to God's presence.
