#### **Translating the Word**

Bonjour! Je m'appelle Katie. Je suis fatigue. Quelle heure est-il? That's about the extent of my French vocabulary. Even after seven years of middle and high school French classes. I may have been a student of foreign language, but I can say with confidence I never was nor will ever be a practitioner of French. Translating between languages is not a gift God graced me with.

Thankfully my discipleship doesn't require translating words. The scripture readings have been translated into English for me so I can understand. My discipleship does, however, compel me to translate in another way – to translate scripture into my heart, my life, and my actions. The Word of God is for doing, not solely for listening. The scripture readings we hear at Mass and the Bible passages we read are alive today and give us life. We cannot study the messages of God and not becoming practitioners, like my French. They are not to be tucked away or forgotten. God's Word is to be lived every day and in every way.

The Word of God is God's music. Imagine if composers and songwriters locked away their music, never to be played for others. No "Ode to Joy" by Beethoven, no "Need a Favor" by Jelly Roll, nor my personal favorite, "Moonlight Serenade" by Glenn Miller. Life would not be the same. It would be expressionless and dull. Cultures, relationships, and creativity would suffer. And movies and TV shows would definitely be less interesting. The same holds true concerning God's Word. If we never open scripture and put God's Words into action, where would we be? Like music, the message of God is to be played, performed, sung, and shared by all of us.

In the Gospel this weekend, Jesus tells an unclean spirit within a man "Be quiet! Come out of him!" and the spirit does as it is told. We too must do what Christ says, we must do what we are told. The Word of God is all around us, ready to be heard. How will you translate the message God sends you today?


