Turn, Turn, Turn

One of my favorite scripture verses is Ecclesiastes 3:1-15 --

*There is an appointed time for everything,
and a time for every affair under the heavens.*

You often hear it proclaimed at weddings or funerals and should you be a Baby Boomer like me, you most likely know the 1960's musical version "Turn, Turn, Turn" famously performed by the Byrds. The scripture verse is often attributed to King Solomon, revered for his great insights into human nature but modern-day scholars are inclined to attribute its origin to others. The music made famous in the 60's was composed by Pete Seeger; he changed up the order of some of the lines and the only lyrics he added to the scripture was the "turn-turn-turn" refrain and the closing line "... a time for peace - I swear it's not too late."



There are countless famous quotes, essays, writings, and insights addressing the archetypes of transition and change and the emotions of opening oneself to the mysterious unknowns of what's next Letting go of what was and turning ourselves over to the mystery of what is possible, what will yet be, trusting in God's promises, this is all so core to our faith. And all of this is my long, drawn-out way of sharing the news of my retirement. Learning to discern God's will for a greater good versus imposing my own ideas and opinions, respecting boundaries, fostering generativity through collaboration, staying open to the signs of the times, and honoring the experiences and dignity of those living on the margins to be as valid as my own - I admit its been unnecessarily complicated at times. Why? Because it took me too long to realize it all simply boils down to love: When am I loving? How am I loving? And who am I loving?

Life is always better experienced with others committed to loving all God's people all of the time. Prayers of gratitude for my time here with you and may love always be your guide as you turn-turn-turn into the next 60 years!

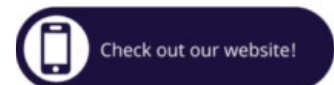

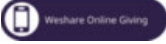
