yearly commitment to transformation, or metanoia, is an important aspect of our church year. We look to Mary, who is an important role model for us.

Two important feast days fall during this coming week's calendar. The Feast of the Immaculate Conception of Mary occurs this Wednesday. Mary recognized and lived out the grace of God which dwelt within her all of her life. 


Reconciliation During Advent

The Third Sunday of Advent is also known as Gaudete Sunday. Gaudete is Latin for rejoice, thus this is the Sunday in Advent that we are to be rejoiceful.

In Italy, households of faith bring their Baby Jesus figurines from their in-home nativity sets to St. Peter's Square to be blessed by the Pope. In Italian, the Baby Jesus figurines are called Gesu Bambinos.

In honor of Bambinelli Sunday, you are invited to bring your Gesu Bambino from home to Resurrection for a blessing at a Mass on the weekend of December 11 & 12.
