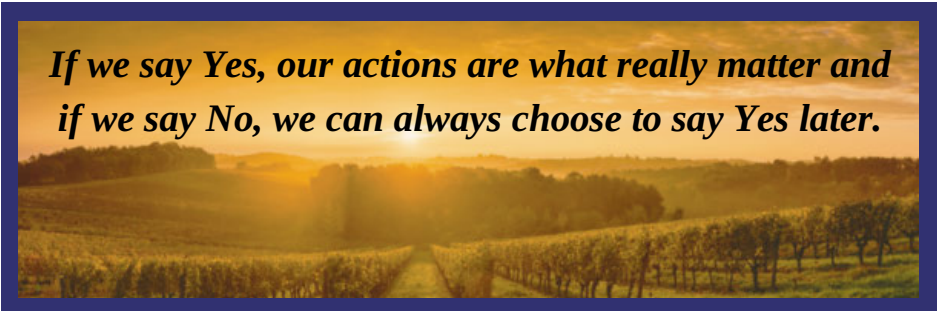

### Which of you has followed God's will?

Most of us start out the day with the intention to live an upright life loving all God's people all the time. At the end of the day, consciously or not, we have a sense of whether it was a good day or not. Our intentions are usually good. Our words and actions don't always match up to our intentions.



Most of us are like the child in our Gospel reading who answered to their father, 'Yes, sir' when asked to do something, but then did not do it. Our intentions are good and noble. Yet we often make plans and fail to complete them as intended.

The other child in our Gospel reading made a dramatic change of heart and mind. They initially said 'no' to their father's request. They were honest! After some soul searching it seems this child 'changed their mind' and went to fulfill the request. It appears there was an emotional refocusing of values as they internalized the father's desires.

So which child fulfilled their father's will? Our answer here is self-incriminating so we may choose to plead the fifth! So often we say YES! in our prayers and our relationships and then get busy or refuse to do the hard work of changing our hearts and minds. Just say YES! and move on...

Jesus uses this parable to commit us to making a real, mature, and calculated decision. Are we following the will of God? Or are we following our own will at our pleasure? The former is our salvation and the latter is our peril. What are you/we called to commit to in order to align our lives to the Kingdom of Heaven? What do we finally need to get to that we have put off for many years?

God's presence on this earth is built upon each of our decisions to love, respect, forgive, and lead a good moral life. Are we up to the challenge?

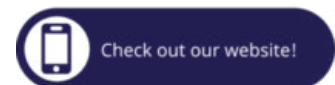


